



Arts Mini-Park: Request for Proposals

Deadline: May 1 (must be built by August 1)

The Arts Mini-Park will transform an unused lawn at Springville Center for the Arts into an interactive art themed mini-park. Located in the heart of pedestrian-friendly Springville, Springville Center for the Arts is a bustling multi-arts center with theater, exhibit, workshop and concert programs housed in an 1869 former church. We are seeking to commission local artists and craftspeople to create interactive elements for the park.

The future site of The Art Mini-Park is a 10 by 100 foot shaded space positioned between the arts center building and Franklin Street. The Arts Mini-Park will utilize a meandering path that will encourage passersby to veer off the sidewalk. Our goal is to incorporate discoverable play and art elements targeting preschoolers through third-graders. Interactive elements might include:

- Wooden structures (benches, arbor, bridge, fences, etc.)
- Sculpture (metal, stone, etc.)
- Interactive chime structure
- Mosaics
- Creative stepping stones
- Things that move
