

Summer 2022 Staff Visual Artist

Springville Center for the Arts is a growing multi-arts center located in a rural community in Western New York State. Programming includes theater, concerts, exhibits, workshops and more based out of an 1869 former church. We are seeking a seasonal Visual Artist to help with our summer programming.

Responsibilities: The Staff Visual Artist is responsible for the Public Art Corps, a program made to *create connections in the community that encourage the reduction of youth substance abuse* with the help of high school-aged artists to deploy temporary and permanent art installations in the Village of Springville. Work with our summer college-aged interns in our multi-arts school program for kids in grades K-12. Interface with the Springville community.

Duties: Lead Public Art Corps in designing Public Art installations. Work closely with Visual Arts and Musical Theater interns in production aspects, and perform in Artsapalooza!, teach workshops during our 6-week school arts program and other related tasks.

Qualifications: Candidates may come from a variety of backgrounds including musical theater, stage management, technical theater, or other fields. The ideal candidate can lead and instruct a group of college interns in the process of set construction, lighting configuration, and audio & sound engineering.

Hours & Compensation: This is a seasonal full-time position beginning the first week of June and ends mid-August (11 weeks). 40 hours per week at \$17 an hour. Housing is provided and will be shared with other staff. View our Art's Cafe apartment here:
