
#### **Employment by Industry:**

# **Population and Income**


The local population was 40,085 in 2019, a decrease of -0.4% from the previous year. Population has grown -3.1% over the past five years (2015-2019). The local population grew slower than the US average in 2019.


### Population Growth (%)

### **Per Capita Income**





#### Job Growth



### Home Price


Home prices in this market averaged \$121,000 in 2019, lower than the US average.


# **Home and Rent Price Forecast**

Home and rent prices are critical drivers of a local economy's overall health. Local Market Monitor founder Ingo Winzer has won the prestigious "Crystal Ball Award" three years in a row. ### Local Market Monitor's Three-Year Home Price Forecast

Home prices in this market averaged 8% growth in 2019, higher than to the US average. Home prices in Wyoming County are forecasted to change by 3% in 2021, 0% in 2022 and 1% in 2023.

#### **Home Price Change**


