Children's Theater Summer Internship / Residency

Springville Center for the Arts is a growing multi-arts center located in a rural community in Western New York State. Programming includes theater, concerts, exhibits, workshops and more based out of an 1869 former church. We are seeking interns for a residency program that involves a wide range of disciplines. Activities include performing, teaching, and managing theater productions.

Springville Center for the Arts offers multiple internship tracks which include:

Musical Theater- Fill all on and off stage roles to produce a touring theater program for elementary age children. Teach a variety of theater workshops during our summer children's program including playwriting, creative movement, and more. Produce/direct a larger scale musical production with local high school and college students.

Technical Theater- Help with all aspects of technical production throughout the summer season including audio, lighting, and scenic production. Work with students running technical equipment and assist in daily workshops.

Music Education- Perform in a theatrical role or solely as accompanist in a touring theater program. Teach/direct a variety of workshops during our summer children's program including choir and ukulele. Accompany/conduct the pit and/or provide musical direction on a larger scale musical production starring local high school and college students.

Arts Administration- Assist team of interns with ticket sales, workshop management, and communications for our summer youth program. Generate promotional materials for a free outdoor concert series, youth theater performances, gallery exhibits, and more.

The program begins the first week of June and ends mid-August (11 weeks).

Housing is provided adjacent to Springville Center for the Arts and will be shared with other interns. Interns receive a stipend of \$175 per week.

Requirements

- Ability to perform for/with children
- You must be seeking a degree in an arts or education related field: Theater, Technical Theater, Music Education, Arts Education, Dance, etc.
- Comfortable working with teaching or leading children in a workshop setting
- Self-initiative. Participants work with staff to create programs.
- Comfort with all areas of theater production. You do not have to have experience with power tools, for example, but you must be willing to learn.
